

Minute of the Pre-Bid meeting held on 3.10.2023 for organisation of Divya Kala Mela at Bangalore, Karnataka from 27th October, 2023 to 5th November, 2023

With reference to the BID NO.GEM/2023/B/4026886 dated 29.9.2023 published on Government e Marketing and also at NDFDC (formerly NHFDC) website for inviting tender for Engagement of Programme Implementing Agency (PIA) to Conceptualize, Design, Plan, Coordinate, Manage and Execute the 10 days "Divya Kala Mela" of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India at Bangalore, Karnataka in the month of October-November, 2023.


As per the above mentioned bid details, the pre-bid meeting held on 3.10.2023 chaired by, General Manager (P&A), NDFDC in presence of Chief Manager (P&A) ~~and the following~~ *in* Bidders/agencies.

The following points have been clarified:

1. The exhibition will be held at HMT Ground, Jallahalli, Bengaluru from 27th October, 2023 to 5th November, 2023.
2. The technical bid will be opened on 11.10.2023 at 10.30 a.m. in the Board Room of NDFDC, DLF Prime Towers, Okhla Phase-I, New Delhi. The bid opening will be followed by Presentations by the bidders. (in place of 10.10.2023 at 9.30 p.m. mentioned in the bid)
3. 75 Octonum Stalls structure on wooden platform covered with water proof Pagoda with approx. size of 10 ft. x 10 ft. for Artisans for showcasing/selling of Handloom/Handicraft Items. Apart from this, 15 food stalls to be provided.
4. The daily Cultural programme to be organised during the Divya Kala Mela shall be arranged by PIA in consultation with NDFDC. The artist /group of cultural programme shall be empanelled with Ministry of Culture, GoI/ State Govt.
5. The cultural programme on Inaugural day & Valedictory day function should be performed by Divyangjan artists.
6. The Venue including Toilets of the Mela should be fully accessible and cleaned during the period of exhibition. The stage and entrance should be made fully accessible to Divyangjans.
7. Food Vendors to be selected by PIA in consultation with NDFDC to represent all regions of the Country.
8. Arrangement should be made for mist fans/water cooler etc. in the common area, if required.
