2. CONCESSIONAL FINANCE TO PwDs (DIVYANAGJAN)

• Sanction of Loan

During the month of April, 2022, the Corporation sanctioned loan amounting to Rs. 16.92 Lakhs for 01 (One) Person with Disability (PwD).

• Release of Loan

During the month of April, 2022, the Corporation released loan amounting to Rs. 11.73 Lakh for 01 (One) PwD under Divyangjan Swavalamban Yojana (DSY).

• Loan Size

As at the end of April, 2022, book size of loans extended for the benefit of Divyangjan was Rs. 383.45 Crores.

• Repayments received

During the month under reference, the Corporation received Rs.11.24 Crores (Rs.9.57 Crores as Principal and Rs.1.67 Crores as interest) as repayments.

3. SIGNING OF AGREEMENT FOR CHANNELISING OF FUNDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF PwDs

An Agreement was signed between Union Bank of India (UBI) and NHFDC on 27th April, 2022 at Corporate office of the Corporation at DLF Prime Tower, Okhla Phase-1, New Delhi for flow of loan assistance to Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) through the branches of UBI.

Hon'ble Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment, GoI visited at the stalls of NHFDC beneficiaries on 2nd April, 2022 and appreciated to products/finished goods made by PwDs.

c) 2nd April, 2022

NHFDC participated in the Awareness Camp at Dimapur, Nagaland organized by S.D. Jain Charitable Clinic. Officials of the Corporation disseminated information concerning the Schemes of the Corporation for the benefit of PwDs at the event.

b) **ACTION TAKEN IN RESPONSE TO COVID-2019**

During the month under reference, following measures were continued/acted upon, to fight against COVID-2019;

- i) All employees were advised to clean hand and face frequently.
- ii) Every employee is being advised to wear Mask, use Sanitizer on regular basis and have been advised to maintain Social distance.
- iii) Reception area/ Entrance to the office were frequently cleaned and sanitized.
- v) Foot operated hand sanitizer machine was continued to be placed at the reception area.
- vi) Wall mounted Thermal scanner (Touch-free) was continued to be placed at the reception area to measure the body temperature of employees/ visitors coming to the office.
