4. SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Under National Scholarship (Trust Fund) Scheme fresh scholarships were released to 558 students with disabilities (400 Fresh + 158 Renewal) aggregating to Rs. 3,24,40,402/- (Rs. Three Crore Twenty Four Lakh Forty Thousand Four Hundred Two only) during the month of January, 2015 for Second Quarter of Academic Year 2014-15.

5. JOB FAIRS/EXHIBITIONS/CAMPS

During the month of January, 2015, the Corporation organised/participated in following Job Fairs/ Exhibitions/Camps for the benefit of Persons with Disabilities:

a) 22nd January, 2015

The Corporation organised a job fair for PwDs on 22.1.2015 at Burdwan (West Bengal). CMD, NHFDC alongwith officials of the Corporation attended the same.

b) 27th January, 2015

The Corporation organised a job fair for PwDs in collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society Faridabad on 27.1.2015 at Drug De-addiction Centre, Sector-14, Faridabad at Drug De-addiction Centre, Sector-14, Faridabad.

iv) **Self Employment under DRI Scheme**

During the Job Fair, Fifteen (15) applications were filled by Sarv Haryana Rural Bank under Differential Rate of Interest Scheme (DRI) Scheme.

v) **Assessment and issue of Disability Certificates**

During the Job Fair, Eight (8) PwDs were issued Disability Certificates and Twenty (22) PwDs were advised to report at Badshah Khan Hospital, Faridabad for further examination.

vi) **Online Registration with Employment Exchange**

20 PwDs shown interest for online registration at the Job Fair.

vii) **Opening of account by banks in Jan Dhan Yojana**

During the Job Fair, fifty applications were received from PwDs for opening of Bank Account under Jan Dhan Yojna by Syndicate Bank (Lead Bank) and Sarv Haryana Rural Bank.

viii) **Registration for Disability Pension**

Thirty five (35) PwDs were registered for Disability Pension.

ix) **Assessment for Assistive Devices for PwDs under ADIP Scheme**

At the Job fair, assessment was carried out by ALIMCO/Red Cross Society in respect of fifty (50) Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).
